**CHOIR/ORCHESTRA GROUP TOUR TO GREECE
(2026)**



(9 days/8 nights)

(DAY 1): - ATHENS ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos", meet your local representative. Enjoy a bus orientation tour of the city before check-in at the hotel. Dinner at hotel and overnight stay. **(D)**

(DAY 2): ATHENS CITY TOUR & MUSEUM – POTENTIAL CONCERT

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, climb up to the marble-capped Acropolis Hill and visit the famous Parthenon and Erechtheion Temples. Then visit the Acropolis Museum built to house only findings from the archaeological site of the Acropolis of Athens and the surrounding slopes from the Greek Bronze Age to Roman and Byzantine Greece. It also lies over the ruins of part of Roman and early Byzantine Athens. Continue your tour with a panoramic sightseeing of the city highlights. Potential for concert on this day at St. Paul's Catholic Church in Piraeus, tbc. Overnight at hotel. **(B)**



(DAY 3): ATHENS – MYCENAE - NAFPLION

In the morning, after breakfast, drive to Mycenae to visit the remains of the pre-historic citadel fortified with the *Cyclopean Walls*, the *Lionesses' Gate*, the remains of the *Mycenaean Palace* and the *Tomb of Atreus*, whose tomb you actually enter. Continue to Nafplion for dinner and overnight stay. **(B,D)**



(DAY 4): NAFPLION – POTENTIAL CONCERT

Enjoy your day at leisure in Nafplion which was the first capital of Greece up until 1834. Beauty, culture, history and tradition characterize this wonderful city. The beautiful old city maintains its own distinct traditional architectural style, with many colorful buildings around the old town, influenced by the Venetian domination there between 1338–1540. Concert confirmed at the Vouleffikon, Greece's first parliament. Overnight in Nafplion. **(B)**



(DAY 5): NAFPLION – EPIDAUROS - ATHENS

After breakfast at hotel, check-out and enjoy some free time before continuing to Epidaurus. Visit the Sanctuary of Asclepeios, dedicated to the god of healing and the best-preserved ancient theater in all of Greece, famous for the harmony of its design and the perfection of its remarkable acoustics, with a seating capacity of 12,000 people. Return to Athens for check in, dinner and overnight stay. **(B,D)**



(DAY 6): MONASTIRAKI & PLAKA - POTENTIAL CONCERT

After breakfast, enjoy a walk around the streets of Monstiraki and Plaka, known as the "Neighborhood of the Gods", built on top of the residential areas of ancient Athens. Cafes, restaurants and shops invite you to partake in the sumptuous culture that is found in a variety of forms around the city. *Potential for concert on this day.* Return to hotel for overnight stay. **(B)**



(DAY 7): ATHENS FREE MORNING – SOUNION - POTENTIAL CONCERT

Enjoy a morning at leisure. Potential for concert at the Greek Evangelical church, tbc.. Then continue with an excursion towards Cape Sounion. Driving along the picturesque coastal road, pass by the beautiful beaches of Kalamaki, Glyfada, Voula, Vouliagmeni and Varkiza, with its countless coves and beautiful blue waters of the Saronic Gulf. A crowning feature of the tour is Cape Sounion, famous for its radiant sunsets and dominated by the Doric white marble Temple of Poseidon that overlooks the blue Aegean Sea. Following the visit to the temple, return to the hotel for overnight stay. **(B)**



(DAY 8): ONE-DAY CRUISE TO HYDRA, POROS & AEGINA

Depart for a cruise to the lovely Greek islands of Hydra, Poros & Aegina including buffet lunch on board. Set sail with first port of call the island of Hydra, a fashionable artists' colony, a retreat for intellectuals and a favorite film location. Time for a leisurely stroll, some shopping or swimming (weather and sea permitting). From here, continue to Poros, marked by delightful scenery with low pine-wooded hills. Continue to your last port of call Aegina, an attractive and tranquil resort destination with an optional guided excursion to the Temple of Aphaia; one of the finest and best preserved of Greek temples, or walk leisurely around the harbor and browse in small gift shops. *Potential singing informally for guests on the cruise.* Return to the port and transfer back to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay. **(B,L,D)**



(DAY 9): ATHENS DEPARTURE

Breakfast and check out of hotel by 11:00 am. Transfer to Athens international Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" for your departure flight home. We hope the memories of Greece will bring you back again! **(B)**
