

SOUTHERN FRANCE CHOIR TOUR

Your program – 9 days / 8 nights

D1 – Arrival to the Côte d'Azur - Nice

Upon arrival, meet your English-speaking tour manager at the airport. After a transfer to the city center of **Nice**, your guide will introduce you to the Côte d'Azur with a walking tour of the city. Discover the promenade des Anglais, the magnificent Place Masséna, the harbor. Enjoy a breathtaking view from the top of the castle hill and finish the day with the delicious scent of blossoms in the flower market. Transfer to your 3/4* hotel in the surroundings of Cannes and check-in. Dinner at the hotel (*or nearby*). Overnight in Cannes.



D3 – Discover Les Gorges du Verdon

Breakfast. Check out. Departure for the **Gorges du Verdon**, the largest canyon in Europe. Stopover in **Moustiers**, visit of this **medieval village** in the Canyon du Verdon, well known for the art of ceramics and old legends. Enjoy the

breathtaking view of the crystal-clear waters and walk around **Lake Sainte Croix**.
Lunch at leisure.



Then your trip continues to **Aix-en-Provence** ; on arrival enjoy a panoramic tour.
Check in your 3/4* hotel in the surroundings of Aix-en-Provence. **Possibility of planning a performance in Aix-en-Provence**. Dinner at the hotel (*or nearby*).
Overnight in the surroundings of Aix-en-Provence.



Optional :

You may want to discover the brand L'OCCITANE en Provence during a guided tour of the factory. You can learn more about the brand's story, natural ingredients, and production methods.

OR

After the panoramic tour, you may choose to visit the Calisson Museum, where you will discover the history and secrets behind this traditional Provençal sweet, and enjoy a tasting experience.

D4 – A journey in Camargues

Breakfast. Check out. Full day excursion to the **Camargue**, wild land of rice fields, white horses, flamingos & birds. In the morning, meet your English-speaking private guide then go to **Aigues Mortes**, this medieval village near the lagoon. Take the road to **Saintes Maries de la Mer** and enjoy a lunch at a typical restaurant. After lunch, enjoy walking in the narrow streets and embark in a boat tour, the best way to discover the fauna and flora of the Camargue. Check in your 3/4* hotel in the surroundings of Avignon. Dinner at the hotel (*or nearby*). Overnight in the surroundings of Avignon.



D5 – In the heart of Provence

Breakfast. This morning, depart from **Avignon** with your English-speaking driver and guide, heading towards the heart of the Alpilles. Your day begins with a visit to the **Carrières de Lumières**, a breathtaking immersive art experience set inside former limestone quarries. Famous artworks are projected onto the monumental stone walls, accompanied by music, creating a truly unforgettable audiovisual journey. After this unique experience, continue to the nearby village of Les Baux-de-Provence, one of the most picturesque in France. Lunch at leisure. Enjoy a guided walking tour through the cobbled streets, historic remains, artisan boutiques, and scenic viewpoints overlooking the Provençal countryside. Discover the rich medieval heritage and charm of this fortified village perched high on a rocky plateau. In the late afternoon, return to Avignon for a guided tour of the city. Explore the historic center, including the legendary Pont d'Avignon and the city walls. Walk through centuries of history in this emblematic papal city of southern France. **Possibility of planning a performance in Avignon.** Dinner and overnight in the surroundings of Avignon.



Optional :

Visit of the Palais des Papes, a majestic and imposing landmark that stands as a living testament to medieval history, offering a glimpse into the 14th-century papal world with its grand halls and breathtaking views over the city and its surroundings.

D6 – The Luberon and its picturesque villages

Breakfast. This morning, head to **Châteauneuf-du-Pape**, a renowned wine- and cheese-producing region in the south of France, where you will enjoy a delightful cheese tasting experience. Lunch at leisure. In the afternoon, drive to the **Abbaye Notre-Dame de Sénanque**, a remarkable Cistercian monastery nestled in a peaceful valley. Admire the abbey church, the former dormitory, the cloister, the warming room, and the chapter house, all built between the 12th and 13th centuries. Continue with a road to **L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue**, known as the “**Venice of the Comtat**”. Enjoy a guided tour of this charming town, famous for its canals and rich heritage. Discover highlights such as the Tour d'Argent, the former public granary, and the picturesque water wheels along the canals. **Possibility of planning a performance in Silvacane Abbaye**. Return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in the surroundings of Avignon.





D7 – Welcome to St Tropez

Breakfast. Check out. Depart for the beautiful village of **Gordes**, one of the most picturesque perched villages in Provence. Wander through its narrow streets, admire the stone houses, the castle, and the stunning views over the **Luberon valley**. After this visit, continue your journey towards the famous town of **Saint-Tropez**. Enjoy lunch at leisure on the way. Upon arrival, explore this mythical village beloved by the international jet set. Soak up the charming bobo-chic atmosphere, stroll along its lively terraces, and browse the boutiques. Don't miss the Place des Lices, where locals and visitors alike gather to play pétanque. Visit the citadel and its museum, offering panoramic views of the bay and insights into Saint-Tropez's maritime history. Transfer to your 3/4* hotel in the surroundings of Saint-Tropez. Check in. Dinner at the hotel (*or nearby*). Overnight in the surroundings of Saint-Tropez.



Optional :

Visit of the Annonciade Museum, home to a remarkable collection of 19th and 20th-century paintings.

D8 – Discover Monaco

Breakfast. After check-out, the coach will bring you to **Monaco**. Start your day in the old town of Monaco, walk through the Saint Marten's garden, admire the Prince Palace and the cathedral where the Prince and Princess Grace Kelly are buried. Follow your tour guide to the glamorous square of the casino of **Montecarlo**, appointment of the international jet set. Lunch at leisure. The visit of Monaco will end in the harbor where the famous Grand Prix of Monaco is held every year. On your way back to Nice, visit **Eze**, another splendid medieval village. Stroll the narrow cobblestone streets with vaulted passageways, discover the baroque church and the cactus garden. Enjoy the amazing view of the coastline. **Possibility of planning a performance in Nice.** Check in your 3/4* hotel in the surroundings of Nice. Dinner at the hotel (*or nearby*). Overnight in the surroundings of Nice.

Optional : *Visit the exotic gardens of Monaco.*





D9 – Jour 9 : Last moments on La côte d'Azur

Breakfast. Check out of your hotel. Transfer to the Nice Côte d'Azur Airport. Return to your country. End of our services.
